

Final Project

The final project for the class is based on the review of patents we did in class. Identify a patent that is related to an ophthalmic technology and read it. The requirements for distance and local students are slightly different.

Local Students

In-class presentation, typically about 8 minutes with a couple of minutes for questions from the audience. You are welcome to use the LCD projector for Powerpoint slides or other materials as part of your presentation. However, get me copies of your presentation beforehand so they can be pre-loaded on the laptop. I don't want to switch computers between each talk.

Distance Students

A 3-5 page summary of the patent technology. Determine what problems it solves and why it is better or different than the preceding technology.

The dates for the in-class presentations are December 2nd and December 7th. There are 8-9 slots per day, so email your preference. First come, first serve.

For the distance students, the 3-5 page summary is due December 9th.
